## AFFHP Applauds Passage of Site-of-Service Billing Transparency

On behalf of the [Alliance for Fair Health Pricing \(AFFHP\)](#), a non-partisan group of organizations that represent patients, employers, and consumers, we applaud Congress for enacting site-of-service billing transparency in the just-passed government funding bill.

With health care costs now the top economic concern for Americans across the political spectrum, according to a new Kaiser Family Foundation [poll](#), passage of the NPI-based site-of-service provision represents a major step toward restoring accountability in the health care system and ensuring patients are not charged more simply because of who owns the building where they receive care.

This is an important step towards lower costs for families and employers, saving taxpayers [\\$2.3 billion over ten years](#) and bringing long-overdue clarity to hospital billing practices that have obscured where care is delivered and why prices vary so wildly.

AFFHP stands ready to continue working with Congress and the Administration to build on this progress and advance common-sense [solutions](#) to address health care prices, the root driver of high health care costs. We remain committed to pushing for reforms that promote transparency, rein in abusive pricing practices, and increase affordability for American families and employers.
